High officials, present at the event



The Ambassador of the European Union to the Republic of Moldova H.E. Jānis Mažeiks inaugurated the event. "Each program supports the priorities of cooperation between the member states of the European Union and its neighbouring countries, whereas the results of the projects are visible throughout the country".

His Excellency, the Ambassador, mentioned that the cooperation programmes bring improvements to areas such as education, culture, research, economic and social domains, security and regional development, giving as an example the inauguration of the museum at the Capriana Monastery and ongoing rehabilitation works of the Soroca Fortress.

Mr. Marius Ciprian Toth, Minister Plenipotentiary at the Romanian Embassy in the Republic of Moldova, said during the event that the program contributes to the implementation of cooperation projects in various fields, emphasizing the importance of large-scale projects implemented by public institutions and recalling the example of SMURD, a project with a significant impact in the Republic of Moldova, but also mentioning the added value of smaller projects regarding the improving the lives of local communities on both banks of the Prut river. Mr. Toth also expressed his hope for the continuity of cross-border cooperation initiatives in the coming period.

The event was also attended by representatives of the Government of the Republic of Moldova, ministers and state secretaries from the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova, several beneficiaries of projects from both banks of the Prut river, as well as the representatives of donor community in the Republic of Moldova.

Cycling race

The 10th edition of European Cooperation Day was also marked by a cycling race. It took place on the Chisinau–Capriana–Chisinau route and was organized in partnership with the <u>Club of Amateur Cyclists of the Republic of Moldova</u> and the <u>Chisinau Urban Cycling</u>.



Around 50 amateur cyclists attended the race, taking part in a trip to the Capriana Monastery, where they had lunch and were acquainted with the ENCAMO project (2SOFT/2.1/76 code), implemented within the Joint Operational Programme Romania–Republic of Moldova 2014–2020.

With the financial support of the European Union, the first religious museum was set up at the Capriana Monastery, having an ecclesiastical heritage discovered after archaeological research.





The cross-border cooperation with the Moldova Museum Complex from Iași conducted, among others, to the joint use of high-performance immersive digital equipment, training and education for the heritage conservation and capitalization.
