PROJECT RESULTS

- 144 staff personnel will benefit directly from the project results and outputs by completing the training sessions for residential/industrial fire associated risks, 72 Romanian and 72 from Republic of Moldova
- emphasis on public awareness aiming to educate and engage communities, raising their understanding of domestic fire risks and promoting sustainable practices
- Purchase of specialized training equipment that will improve the firefighters response by strengthening their knowledge at fire behaviour courses and different methods for search and rescue in confined spaces.
- Joint workshops for the updating the Common procedure regarding the monitoring and notification of emergencies/disasters/exceptional situations and for the provision of emergency medical assistance in the Romanian-Moldovan cross-border area.
- Common training curriculum
- 12 joint training sessions
