PROJECT RESULTS

- Purchase of specialized emergency equipment: 2 high capacity mobile generators, 2 fire engines, 1 autogreder, 1 snow service vehicle.
- Trainings for the use of the specialized emergency equipment.
- To assure an effective, cross-border approach, trainings will be conducted simultaneously, by both partners, at one partners' site. It will facilitate cross-training sessions where emergency responders from both communes have the opportunity to learn about each other's equipment and procedures. This promotes cross-border collaboration. By conducting these training programs, the emergency responders in Stauceni Commune, Botosani county and Stauceni City, Chisinau Municipality will be well-prepared to use specialized emergency equipment in a coordinated and effective manner during real-life emergencies.
