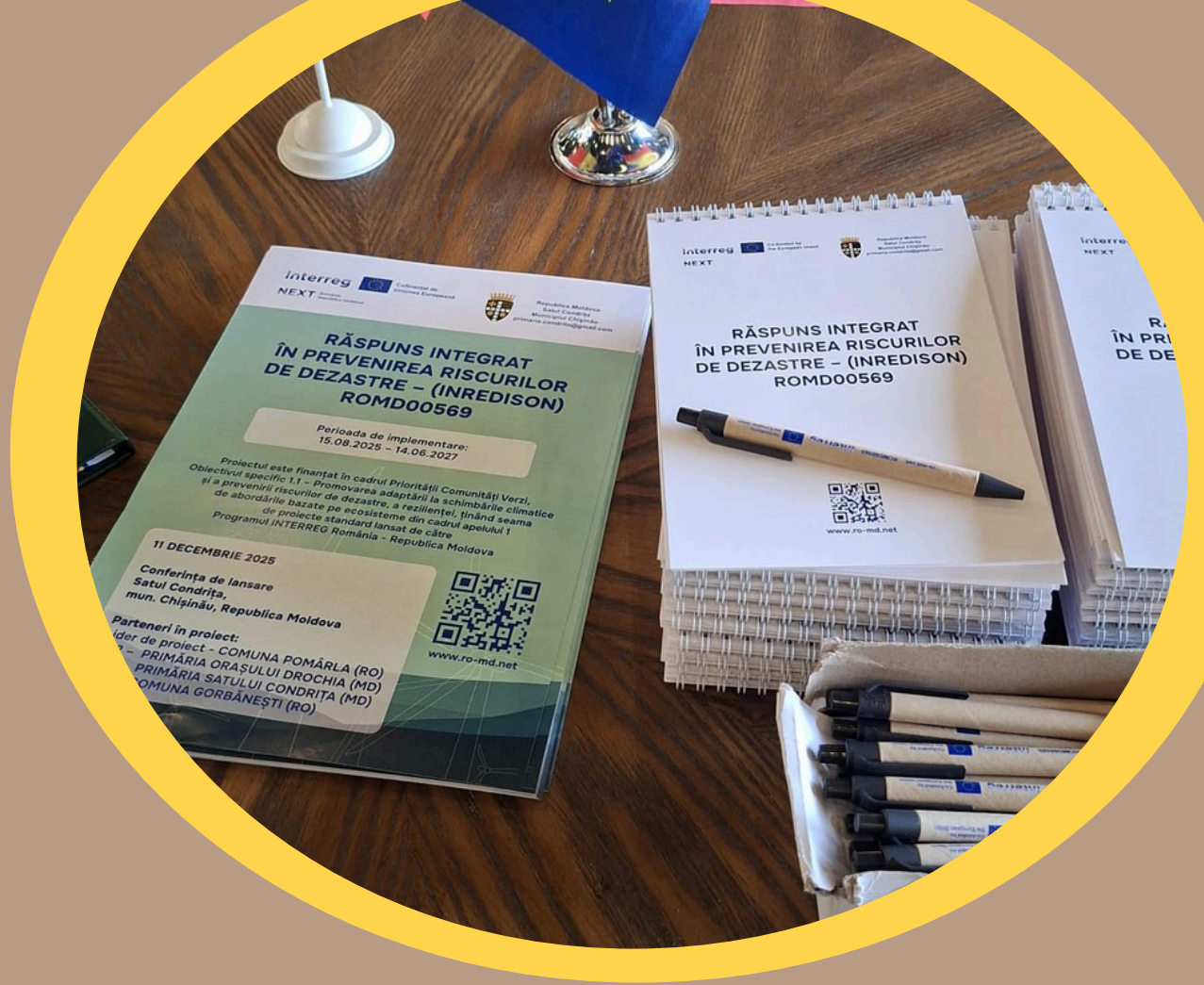


PROJECT OBJECTIVE

- 1 rainwater channel cleaned and rehabilitated in the village of Condrița, Republic of Moldova,
- 1 Volunteer Rescue Unit for Emergency Situations rehabilitated in Drochia, Republic of Moldova
- 3 intervention units endowed with specialized equipment in Pomarla, Drochia and Gorbanesti
- 2 joint training sessions and involving the volunteer units from both Romania and Republic of Moldova to enhance coordination and efficiency during actual emergencies.
- 1 common intervention plan approved and valid for all parties, aimed at adapting partner communities to exceptional situations in the context of climate change.
