- Design and development of an evidence-based capacity-building program, comprising Needs Assessment Methodology, Needs Assessment Report, and the Capacity-Building Program.
- Capacity-building on EU Guidelines for transitioning from residential to community-based care, including 5 trainings for 20 ATAS professionals and 2 workshops.
- 30 coaching sessions
- 130 mentoring sessions
- 3 study visits, 2 in Romania for 24 Moldovan Specialists and 1 in Moldova for 12 Romanian specialists;
- A professionals' network
- One networking event organized offline;
- One awareness campaign.
